**Carlos Rodriguez** rose to introduce our speaker, Superintendent of Marietta City Schools, Dr. Grant Rivera. While he is a Kiwanian, our speaker stated that he is very moved by what Rotary does for the community. Following along with RCoM's 100th Anniversary Literacy Project, Marietta City Schools are also making literacy a priority. The goal is to have every child kindergarten ready. This begins with the Early Learning Center which uses activitybased exercises to help students with reading and math. The center is dedicated to developing the reading brain by working on understanding letters, sounds and syllables. These activities will get the early learning center students ready for kindergarten. By first and second grades the students are focusing on phonics.

Dr. Rivera was approached a few years ago by a parent who said that she could not enroll her child in a Marietta City School because her child was dyslexic. Other parents voiced this issue to Dr. Rivera so he implemented the Orton-Gillingham approach to reading in all Marietta City Schools. Select teachers were trained in this approach which helps those with dyslexia and other reading differences learn to read.

Dr. Rivera answered questions and President Chris told him that we will be donating a book named in his honor to a Marietta City School. This week's book was The Adventures of Paddington.

The Opportunity Drawing was administered by **Joe DeSantis** and **Brooke Cohen**. Alas, neither **Daniel White** nor **Bill Dunaway** were able to locate the red marble.

Dan Kirk led us in the Pledge and 4-Way test and our meeting was adjourned.
