bachelor's degree in journalism from Indiana University in 1980, he began work as a reporter/photographer at the Greensburg (IN) Daily News and was named editor of that paper in 1983. He later moved to The Republic newspaper in Columbus, IN, where, over the next 13 years, he served as city editor, news editor, and managing editor.

Murphy came south to the Gwinnett Daily Post in 1998 as executive editor. He was named Publisher in 2005. In 2013, he was appointed Vice President/Content with responsibilities for all seven newspapers of Southern Community Newspapers, Inc. In April of 2015, he moved to the Marietta Daily Journal.
